### SUMMARY

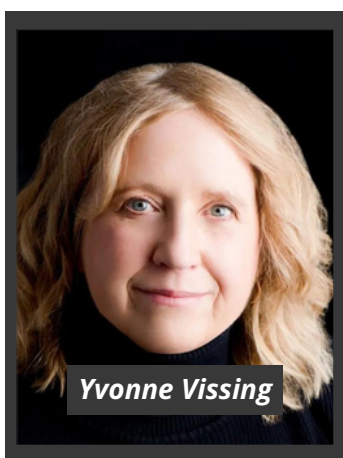
