SUMMARY

Education can be an empowering force for learners, and human rights education can be particularly empowering as learners take ownership of their rights. Through a panel discussion, this module will engage participants in a discussion around human rights education's capacity to empower youth and how to empower youth from a human rights lens in their work.

OBJECTIVES

- Define Article 29 of the Convention on the Rights of the Child and discuss the connection between Article 29 and education as a tool for youth empowerment
- Examine trends related to youth rights in human rights advocacy
- Identify methods of effectively communicating ownership and agency of one's rights to youth
- Strategize ways to support youth building skills related to agency, independence, accountability, and empathy

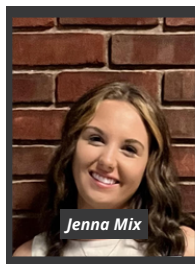

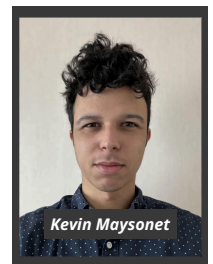
