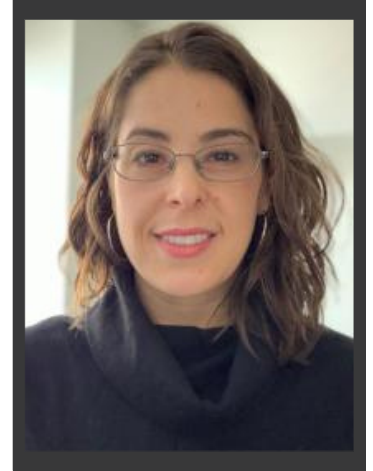
OBJECTIVES
